The EWC hosted the first Pilgrimage in 1949, since then they have raised over one million dollars towards this cause.

Grant Information

Pilgrimage Net proceeds are to support the preservation and restoration of historic buildings and artifacts in Edenton and Chowan County and projects that promote history through education and programming.

- Completed grant applications due by March 28, 2025.
- Actual awards will be determined by a vote of the membership at a general meeting with each grant request voted on separately.
- Awards will be presented to the successful applicants at the 2025 June Picnic.

Criteria for Grant Application

- Historic Buildings and/or Artifacts Preservation and/or restoration of Historic Buildings in Edenton and Chowan County to the best of their ability.
 - The building must be at least 100 years old
 - The historic building must be a Public Building
- Projects that promote history through education and programming.

Responsibilities of Grant Recipients

- Provide the committee with a timeline for the specified project.
- Update GFWC EWC on the progress of the project
- Confirmation of the completed project with a visual or written article for GFWC EWC to use in promotions.
- If the project is not completed one year after the distribution of Grant funds, provide GFWC EWC with a status report.
